

National Cheng Kung University Department of Environmental Engineering Regulations for Award and Scholarship Donations

Article 1

To encourage alumni and benefactors from all sectors of society to contribute funds for rewarding outstanding students in this Department, and to encourage enrolled students to diligently pursue academic excellence and actively participate in departmental public service, these **Regulations for Award and Scholarship Donations of the Department of Environmental Engineering, National Cheng Kung University** (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are hereby established.

Article 2

Donations under the Regulations may be accepted in the following forms, and the donor may designate the name of the scholarship or award:

1. Individuals
2. Public and private organizations
3. Government agencies and associations
4. Others

Article 3

All donations received under the Regulations shall be deposited into the designated account of the “Department of Environmental Engineering” under the **NCKU Foundation** and shall be managed by the department's administrative staff.

Article 4

The application, selection, and awarding procedures of each donated scholarship shall follow its respective regulations. If no separate regulations have been established for a particular scholarship, the Department shall enact specific implementation rules for such donations.

Article 5

Students of this Department may apply for scholarships in accordance with the prescribed procedures. Each student may receive at most one donated scholarship from the Department in a single selection process.

Article 6

The Department shall appropriately recognize and express gratitude to donors. For donations exceeding NT\$100,000 in a single contribution, or totaling over NT\$300,000 cumulatively, the Department may display a donor nameplate.

Article 7

Donation certificates for scholarships collected under the Regulations shall be issued in accordance with the relevant rules of the **NCKU Foundation**.

Article 8

The Regulations shall be implemented upon approval by the Department Affairs Meeting. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
