Guidelines for the Establishment of the Alumni Association

Department of Environmental Engineering, National Cheng Kung

University

Approved at the 258th Department Affairs Meeting on September 19, 2007

1. The official name of the Association shall be: "Alumni Association of the Department of Environmental Engineering, National Cheng Kung University" (hereinafter referred to as "the Association").

2. Purpose:

The Association is established to cultivate talent in environmental engineering, support the teaching, research, and development of the Department of Environmental Engineering at National Cheng Kung University, strengthen alum bonds, promote mutual support and cooperation, and foster unity among members. Its main functions include:

- 1. Promoting communication among alums and organizing networking and care-related activities.
- 2. Encouraging academic exchange, assisting industrial research and development, offering technical consultation, and rewarding outstanding talents.
- 3. Promoting collaboration among government, academia, and industry in environmental engineering both domestically and internationally.
- 4. Organizing regular meetings and assisting in reunions for graduating classes.
- 5. Collecting alumni-related information and publishing newsletters or other communication materials.
- 6. Providing scholarships, financial aid, and loans for students.
- 7. Supporting and sponsoring activities for faculty and students, and assisting the Department's teaching and research development.
- 8. Helping alums with academic, employment, and technical issues, and recognizing outstanding alum achievements.

3. General Membership:

All alums and current/former faculty and staff who have studied or graduated from the Sanitary Engineering Division of the Department of Civil Engineering (including graduate programs) or from the Department of Environmental Engineering (including graduate programs) at National Cheng Kung University are considered members of the Association.

The Association is located in the Department of Environmental Engineering building at National Cheng Kung University.
