

National Cheng Kung University Department of Environmental Engineering Professor Chun-Te Li Poverty Scholarship Selection Regulations

Approved by the 270th Department of Environmental Engineering Department Affairs Meeting on November 1, 2008

I. Purpose These regulations are explicitly established for the selection of undergraduate students from the National Cheng Kung University Department of Environmental Engineering (hereinafter referred to as "the Department") applying for the Department's Professor Chun-Te Li Poverty Scholarship (hereinafter referred to as "the Scholarship").

II. Source and Allocation of Scholarship Funds The Scholarship is funded by the annual interest generated from the principal of NT\$1,700,000 (One Million Seven Hundred Thousand New Taiwan Dollars) donated by Professor Chun-Te Li from the previous year. The allocation is as follows:

(A) If the annual interest is greater than or equal to NT\$40,000: The scholarship will be awarded to 1 student from each year (first-year students, sophomores, juniors, and seniors), totaling four recipients, with each receiving NT\$10,000 per year. (B) Suppose the annual interest is between NT\$30,000 and NT\$39,999. In that case, the scholarship will be awarded to one student from each of the first three years (first-year students, sophomores, and juniors), totaling three recipients, with each receiving NT\$10,000 per year. (C) If the annual interest is between NT\$20,000 and NT\$29,999, the scholarship will be awarded to one student from each of the first two years (first- and second-year students), totaling two recipients, with each receiving NT\$10,000 per year. (D) If the annual interest is between NT\$10,000 and NT\$19,999, the scholarship will be awarded to one freshman only, with a scholarship amount of NT\$10,000. (E) If the annual interest is less than NT\$10,000, the scholarship will be suspended for that academic year. (F) If the remaining accumulated interest from previous years exceeds NT\$10,000, an additional scholarship recipient may be added. The award will be given to a student from a year group that did not receive an allocation that year. If more than two year groups did not receive an allocation, priority will be given to the lower year group.

III. Implementation The Scholarship shall be implemented starting from the 99th academic year.

IV. Application Period Applicants for the Scholarship must submit their application to the Department Office within one month of the start of the first semester of each academic year.

V. Required Application Documents Applicants must submit the following documents: (A) One copy of the Department Scholarship Application Form. (B) One photocopy of the student ID card. (C) One original copy of the university transcript, the exam scores from the College Entrance

Selection Examination or the Designated Subject Examination (or the applicant's ranking within the admission roster provided by the Department). (D) One copy of the autobiography (including personal resume and a description of the family situation). (E) One original copy of the certificate of financial need or low-income household status.

VI. Scholarship Review The selection criteria for first-year students will be based on the scores from the College Entrance Selection Examination or the Designated Subject Examination (or the applicant's ranking within the admission roster provided by the Department). The selection criteria for returning students will be based on their academic performance from the previous year.

VII. Tax Responsibility Scholarship recipients are required to bear the burden of any related income tax themselves.

VIII. Review Authority The Scholarship will be reviewed and approved by the Department's Academic Committee.

IX. Amendments These Scholarship Selection Regulations shall take effect upon approval and announcement by the Department Affairs Meeting. Any subsequent amendments shall follow the same procedure.
